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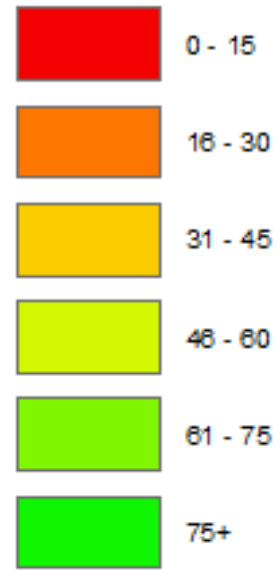

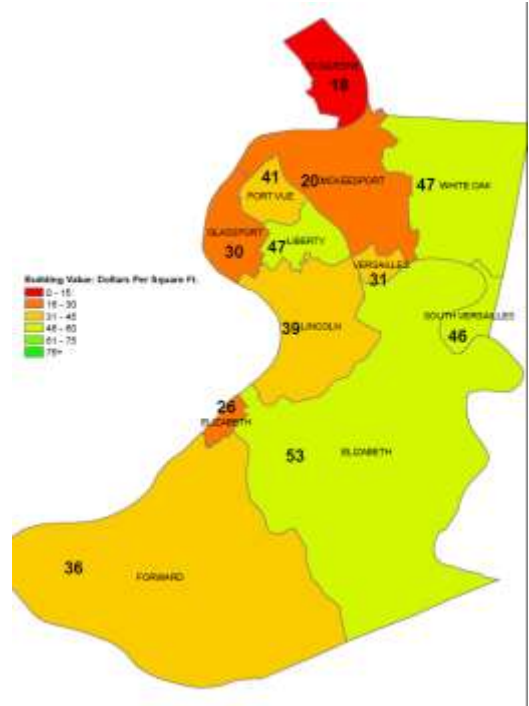
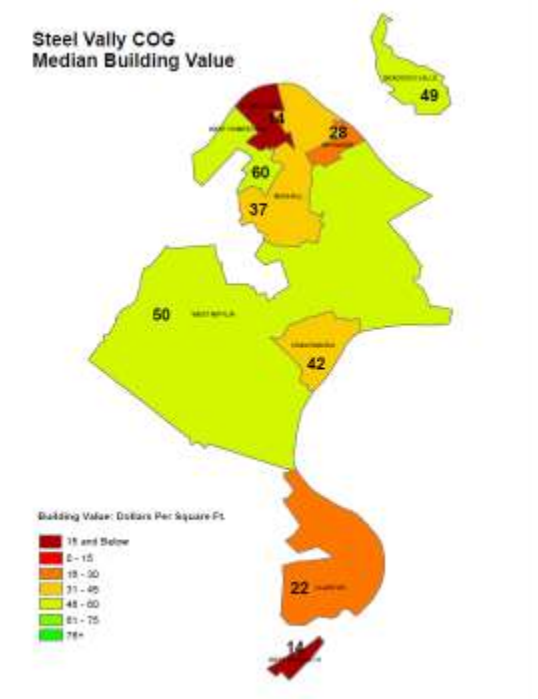

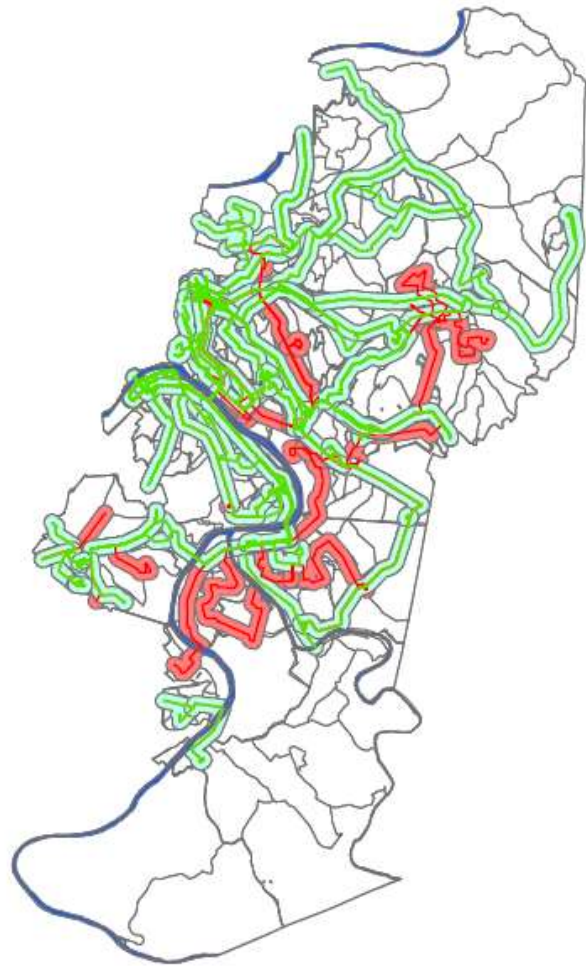
Building Value: Dollars Per Square Ft.





# Further Map Work Building Value Maps for Each COG



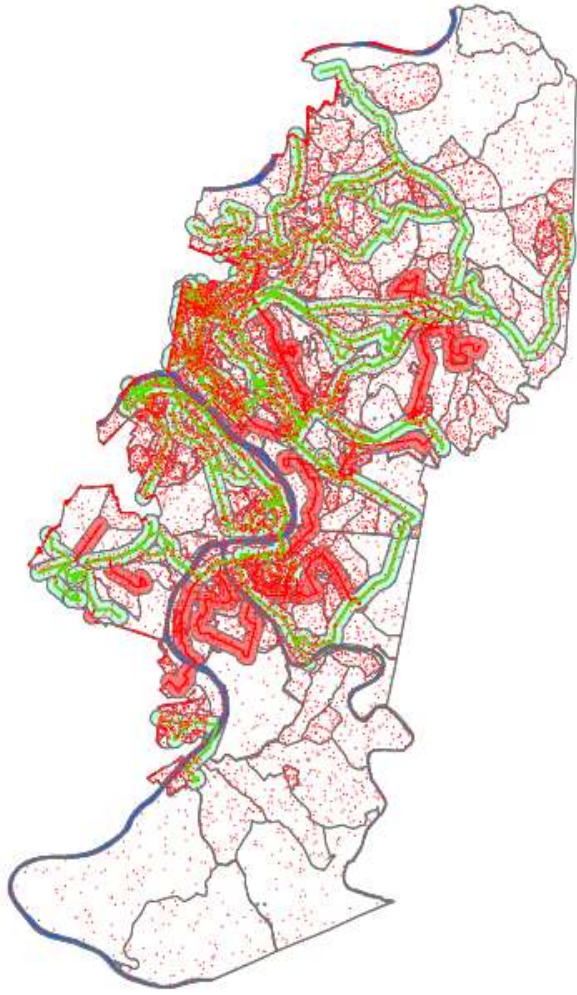
# Routes Changes

-  Service Lost Area

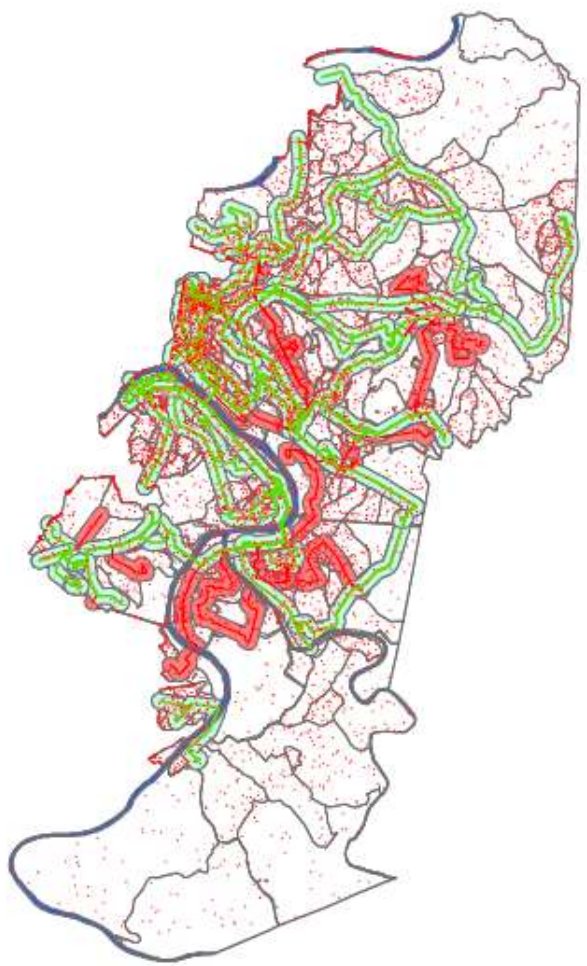
# Total Population

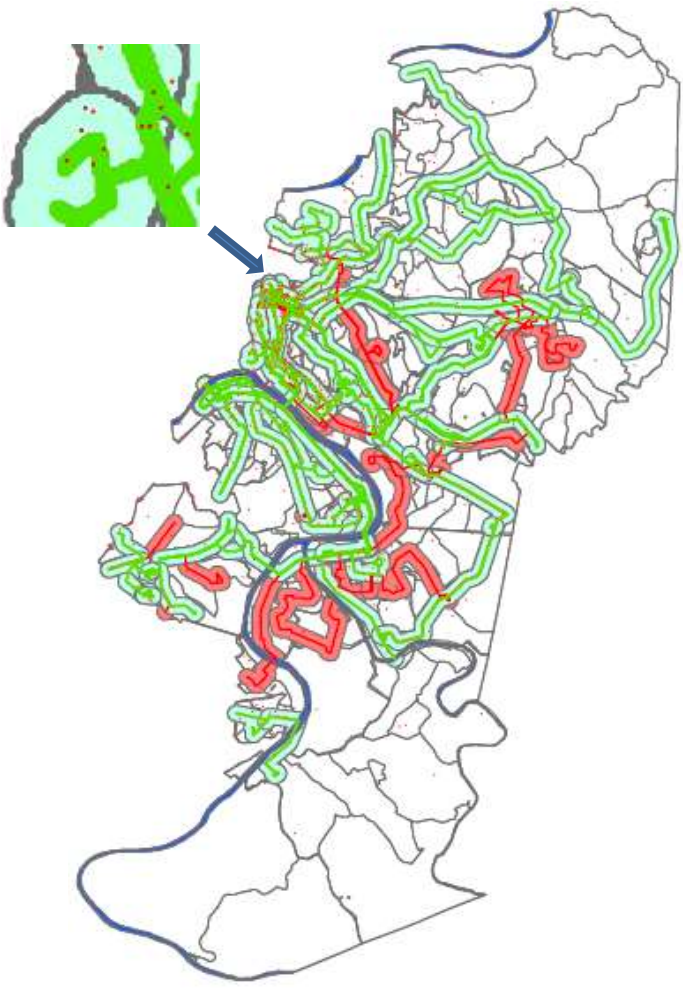
# Working Population
